



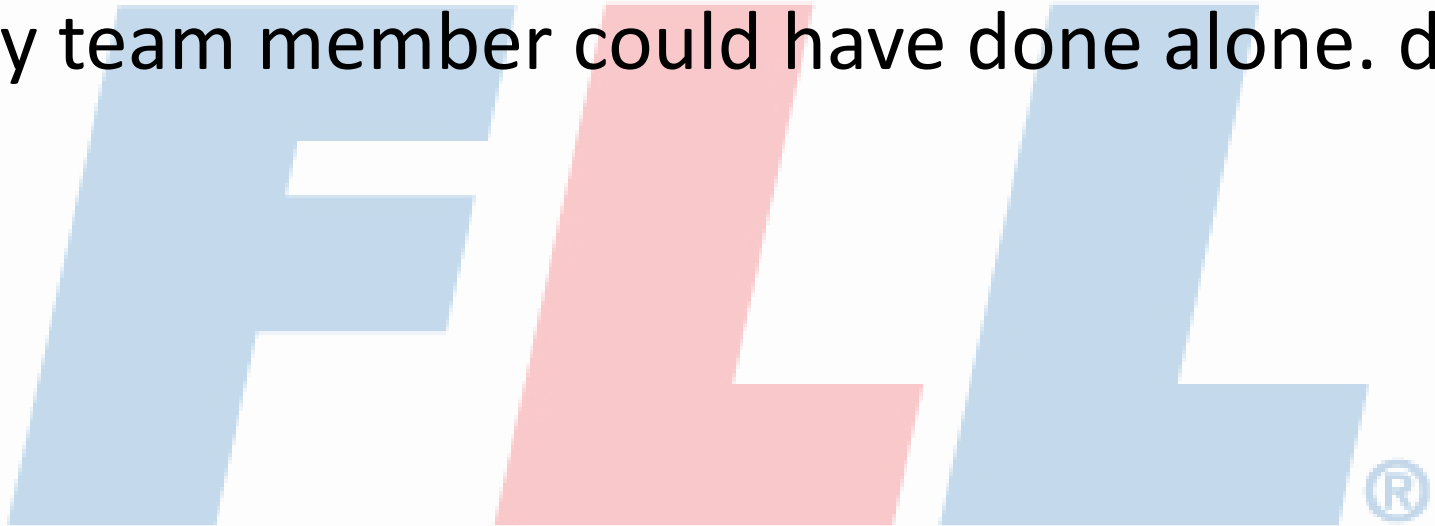
Integration:

- Provide examples of how your team applied the Core Values and other things you learned through FIRST LEGO League to situations outside of team activities. Let the judges know how team members integrated new ideas, skills and abilities into their everyday life. e.



Inclusion:

- Describe how your team listened to and considered ideas from everyone and made each team member feel like a valued part of the team. Share with the judges how they accomplished more by working together than any team member could have done alone. d.



Coopertition:

- Describe how your team honors the spirit of friendly competition. Include information about how your team provided assistance to and/or received assistance from other teams. Share with the judges how your team members help each other, and help other teams to prepare for a potentially stressful competition experience.



Other:

- Use the middle of the poster to highlight anything else your team would like to share with the judges about the remaining Core Values criteria. Maybe consider sharing examples of team spirit, respect, or teamwork.



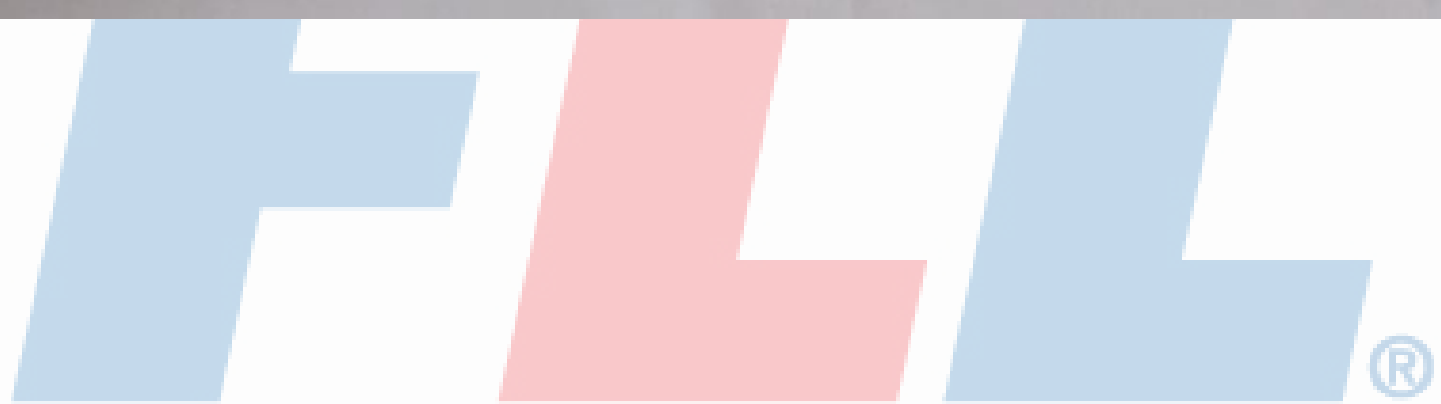
