



#### FIRST® Student Participation Growth in Kansas City





(25% of budget, Board would like 33%)


#### FIRST Financials – FY19 (July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019)

#### FIRST EXPENSES - \$372,497

   FIRST Team Grants \$64,546
  - FTC Summer Camps \$21,751

#### KC STEM Alliance grants to FIRST teams

- Still can apply till midnight tomorrow (Friday)!!!
- For FTC and FRC teams in the 6 county KC area
- Include a team budget
- Range is \$500 to \$3500 per team with an average of \$2000
- Total pool is \$50,000
- Basis of award
- Requirements
- New this year! teams must apply for this grant to be eligible for travel grants
- Also from *FIRST* : <u>Equity and Access Grant</u> !!!
